Scenario	Outcome
A resident with no speech capacity.	Staff learned that she loves Elvis Presley. 'Tin Can Alley' has been a big hit with her and allows her an outlet for her emotions.
A lot of residents have missed going to church during the COVID-19 Pandemic.	The hymns section on RITA has been a great addition and comforted the residents who have missed their regular church services. This helps the residents stay in touch with their faith, keep up a regular routine and engage their mental health with meaningful interests.
A lady with advanced dementia	A resident with advanced dementia struggles to communicate her thoughts and feelings to the people around her. With the help of RITA, the staff have discovered that she loves the relaxation sessions and that she also enjoys using the piano activity.

Atholl House have a Jamaican resident who is blind. This alone creates its own challenges for the resident. The staff used RITA to find person centred content that he would absorb and engage with. They came across some Jamaican music that the resident loved to listen to which boosted his spirits.
